(Washington, DC) – The following statement was released by State Department Spokesman Ian Kelly on Friday, August 28:

“The Department of State has consulted with the Government of Libya regarding the impending visit of Colonel Muammar Qadhafi to attend the General Assembly of the United Nations in New York.”

“In keeping with prior arrangements, the Englewood, New Jersey property is not available for any use in connection with the upcoming visit.”
