

## Projects reported to the House Transportation and Infrastructure Committee, for the Water Resources Development Act Reauthorization

Project: Language to authorize the U.S. Army Corps to construct park/recreation space at Joseph G. Minish Passaic Riverfront Park and Historic Area project in Newark.

Amount Requested: N/A (Language Request)

Project: To extend the boundaries of the Joseph G. Minish Passaic Riverfront Park and Historic Area project in three areas in Newark.

Amount Requested: \$30,000,000

Project: GIS/GPS mapping of stormwater facilities for Essex County's 22 municipalities.

Amount Requested: \$5,000,000

Project: To construct reinforcements to bulkheads to prevent further erosion of soil and stabilize these areas for continued use as public port facilities in Jersey City.

Amount Requested: \$3,500,000

Project: The Corps of Engineers is constructing the 50 foot harbor deepening project for the NY/NJ region.

Amount Requested: \$120,000,000. NOTE: This is new funding, but rather a reprogramming of funds from the amount authorized for the Harbor Deepening Program.

Project: To enact legislation that ties the NY/NJ Harbor Maintenance Trust Fund (HMTF) annual appropriations levels to annual HMTF revenues.
