Washington, DC — It has been reported that “unclaimed refunds totaling approximately \$36.5 million are awaiting about 31,000 New Jerseyans who did not file a federal income tax return for 2007.”

The “IRS estimates that half of those who could claim refunds for tax year 2007 would receive more than \$705,” and that it is important for local taxpayers to claim their funds from their 2007 returns by April 18, 2011.

“I urge all of my constituents who may have unclaimed refunds to contact my Hackensack office at (201) 646-0808 for help with reaching out to the IRS,” said Congressman Steve Rothman. “During these tough economic times it is more important than ever to make sure local taxpayers get all the money they are owed.”
