Washington, DC – On Thursday, May 12, 2011, Ambassador Pavlos Anastasiades, the Ambassador from Cyprus to the United States, visited with Congressman Steve Rothman (D-NJ), a member of the House Appropriations Subcommittee on State and Foreign Operations, in the Congressman’s Washington, DC office.

Since joining the State and Foreign Operations Subcommittee in 2001, Congressman Rothman has helped Cyprus secure more than \$160 million in foreign aid from the U.S. The Ambassador and Congressman Rothman discussed funding priorities for Cyprus for the coming year, the status of the talks between Turkey and Cyprus, and the importance of the U.S.-Cyprus alliance in a host of other areas, including the war on terror.
