Washington, DC — On May 23, 2011, Congressman Steve Rothman (D-NJ), a member of the House Appropriations Defense Subcommittee, gave two presentations titled “Enduring Partnership: Missile Defense Cooperation” at the annual American Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC) Policy Conference in Washington, DC. He was joined by Arie Herzog, Director of the Israel Missile Defense Organization, Jeff Kuhnreich, Deputy Director of Policy and Government Affairs for AIPAC, before hundreds of conference attendees.

The presentations focused on the importance, history and nature of the joint U.S.-Israel missile defense programs. Since Congressman Rothman joined the House Appropriations Subcommittee on Defense in 2007, Congress has allocated nearly one billion dollars toward U.S.-Israel missile defense.
