Washington, DC – Congressman Steve Rothman (D-NJ) released the following statement on the recent defacement of Congregation K’Hal Adath Jeshuran, a synagogue in Paramus, NJ:

The attack on Congregation K’Hal Adath Jeshuran in Paramus is the third anti-Semitic incident targeting a local synagogue in the past month. In addition to anti-Semitic graffiti found at synagogues in Hackensack and Maywood last month, this recent anti-Semitic activity has unfortunately grown into a disturbing trend.

Anti-Semitism has lead to some of the worst atrocities in human history and these incidents are a reminder that there still remain deranged individuals who ascribe to the hatred of the Jewish people. Those who perpetrated these senseless anti-Semitic attacks must be found and prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
