

Jordanian King Meets with Congressman Rothman at the US Capitol

Washington, DC – On January 18, 2012, King Abdullah of Jordan, along with his Prime Minister, Awn Khasawneh, and Foreign Minister, Nasser Judeh, met with Congressman Steve Rothman (NJ-9), and nine other Congressional leaders from the House Appropriations Committee, at the US Capitol in Washington, DC. They discussed the latest developments in the Middle East – including events in Syria, Iran, Lebanon, Turkey, and Egypt – and the status of the negotiations between the Israelis and Palestinians, which are now occurring under the sponsorship of the Jordanian King.

Furthermore, they spoke about the high level of military and intelligence cooperation between Israel and Jordan and the status of the Muslim brotherhood and political reforms in Jordan, where meaningful municipal and national elections are expected this year for the first time.
