Washington, DC – On February 15, 2012, Dr. Glen Gabert, President of Hudson County Community College (HCCC), and Trustees of the HCCC, Jim Fife and Al Zampella, met with Congressman Steve Rothman (D-NJ) in his Washington, DC office to thank him for helping lead the fight to provide access to higher education.
