Washington, DC — On Wednesday June 20, 2012, Congressman Steve Rothman (D-NJ) welcomed Congressional Art Competition winner, Teresa Park, and her father, Jongwon Park, to his Washington, DC office.

Teresa, a resident of Leonia and a student at Leonia High School, took home the first place prize in Congressman Rothman's annual Congressional Art Competition, which was held on May 3, 2012 at the Flyway Gallery Meadowlands Environmental Center in Lyndhurst, for her winning drawing "David."
