Rothman Votes to Keep Ergonomic Standards

Washington, DC -- Congressman Steve Rothman (D-NJ9) voted tonight in favor of keeping ergonomics standards designed to help American workers. He issued the following statement:

"Ergonomics regulations designed to reduce painful injuries that affect 600,000 workers were not put together overnight: These regulations took ten years to produce, more than 1,000 witnesses were heard from and more than 7,000 written comments were submitted," Rothman said. "Yet without public hearings, it has taken the Republican Congress two days to destroy those ten years of work. That is simply wrong."
