

## Garfield

The City of Garfield, found in Southern Bergen County, is home to almost 30,000 New Jersey residents. Garfield's main attractions include the Dundee Dam, two county parks, and a naturally occurring waterfall on the Passaic River which built up over the years. Residents enjoy community events such as the July 4th fireworks displays, the annual Christmas tree lighting, and recreational sports leagues for children.

Garfield was originally incorporated as a borough and was named in honor of United States President James Garfield. Historically, Garfield is known for being the location where British troops crossed the Passaic River in pursuit of General Washington's forces during the Revolutionary War.
