

## North Arlington

The Borough of North Arlington, located in Southern Bergen County, is home to about 15,100 residents. The Passaic River forms this town's western border with Essex County. Families living in North Arlington can choose from a host of recreational activities, including a sports program for children with disabilities, which serves residents of North Arlington and surrounding towns.

This borough has a rich history. The first copper mine in the United States was built here, as well as the first working steam engine in North America. The borough is also recognized by Holy Cross Cemetery, which covers a large portion of the borough and where nearly 250,000 individuals are interred.
